Text: James 5:7-9

#### I. PRACTICING \_\_\_\_\_ UNTIL JESUS RETURNS

- “Patient” means “\_\_\_\_\_ -tempered.”
- The \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ is to be our incentive for patient waiting.
- *“Be patient, brothers and sisters—soon, the Lord Himself will be \_\_\_\_\_ of you.”*
