**“Wise and Godly”**

**Text: James 3:17-18**

**I. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF GODLY WISDOM (v.17)**

- James begins with the \_\_\_\_\_ quality.
- *Peace-loving* refers to both the desire to have peace within oneself and the passion to make peace with \_\_\_\_\_.
- *Gentle* “conveys the thought of \_\_\_\_\_ for the feelings of others.” -D.E. Hiebert
- *Willing to yield to others*—“easily \_\_\_\_\_.”
- *Mercy* means “to see a need and then \_\_\_\_\_ it.”
- True, Godly wisdom will be \_\_\_\_\_.
- The wise and Godly person is not hypocritical—he is free from all \_\_\_\_\_.

**II. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF GODLY WISDOM (v.18)**

- Goodness sewn in the atmosphere of \_\_\_\_\_ will be the fruit of Godly wisdom.
- *Salt of the earth* means that believers would act as \_\_\_\_\_ in a decaying and decadent world.
