### *“Faith That Works”*

Text: James 2:14-18

#### I. THE \_\_\_\_\_ PONDERED (v.14)

- We would be hard-pressed to recognize anything different about him by simply observing his \_\_\_\_\_.
- Romans 3:28 & James 2:24 are “*complimentary* rather than \_\_\_\_\_.” -Alexander Ross
- Works without an understanding of *mercy* and *grace* would be just as \_\_\_\_\_ as faith without action!

#### II. THE \_\_\_\_\_ PICTURED (vs.15-16)

- “*If you see a brother or sister in \_\_\_\_\_*”(NEB)
- It is both *useless* and *unScriptural* to send someone to \_\_\_\_\_ for help when He has most likely sent *them to us!*
- 2010 version of James 2:16- “*Good \_\_\_\_\_ with that problem!*”

#### III. THE \_\_\_\_\_ PRONOUNCED (vs.17-18)

- When *belief* is wounded by a complete lack of *behavior*, that wound is always \_\_\_\_\_.
- It will only be through our \_\_\_\_\_ that people can “see” the difference that Jesus has made.

- Once a person has been truly saved, those good deeds *must* and *will* flow \_\_\_\_\_ from his life to bless and challenge others.
